

Use of Focus on Real Aging in Maine Photo Library

All of the photographs in the FRAME Image Library are free to use by any group, non-profit, or other organization that is looking for photographs that highlight the diversity of aging experiences in Maine.

The FRAME Image Library is hosted on [FlickrR](https://bit.ly/MGSFRAMEFlickrR) (bit.ly/MGSFRAMEFlickrR) and in [Google Photos](https://bit.ly/MGSFRAMELib) (bit.ly/MGSFRAMELib). To download a photo in FlickrR, you will be prompted to make your own account. It is simple and free. When you see a photo you like, tap or click on it. Then tap the “share icon” and select “save” to save the photo.

All images are published under the [CCO license to Attribution—no Derivatives 4.0](https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by-nd/4.0/). This means:

- Photos can be used for non-commercial uses. However, we request that you credit the photographer and acknowledge that the photo was part of the FRAME photo contest.
- Photos may not be transformed or built upon; they must be used in their original state. You may not use or in any way distribute an altered image.
- Please use the photographs with consideration for the people who agreed that their images could be used in the library. Do not use the photos for stories on sensitive topics or to imply that the UMaine Center on Aging, Maine Gerontological Society, or person in the photo supports a specific position or belief.
- Do not use the photos in a way that defames or shows the person in the image in a negative light.

All of the individuals featured in the photographs have signed releases that are kept on file by UMaine Center on Aging and the Maine Gerontological Society.
